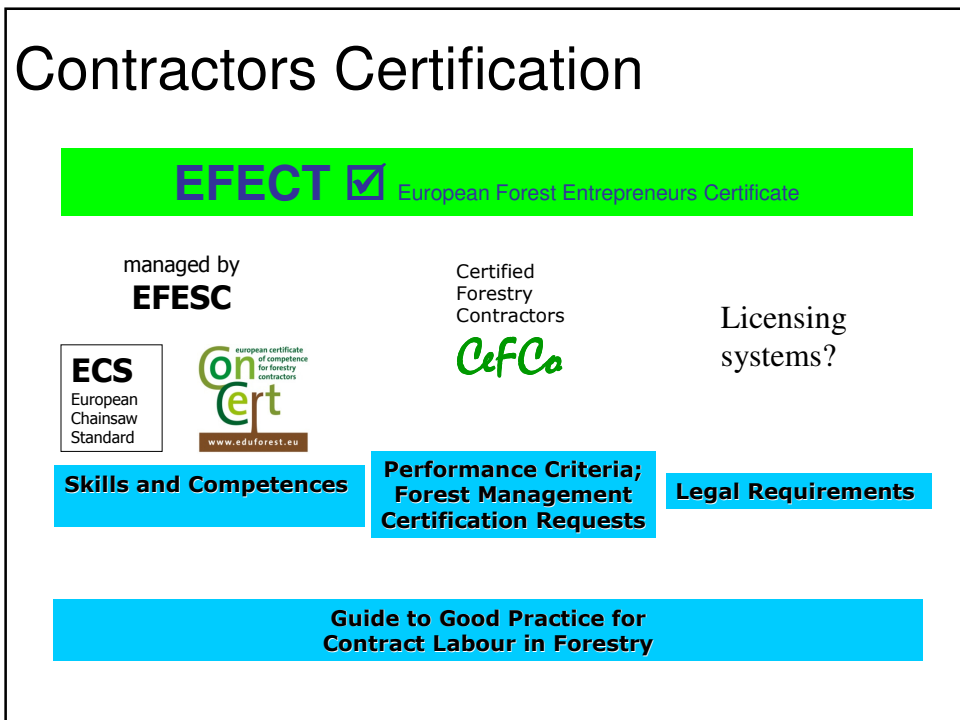


Forest Enterprise Development Strategy

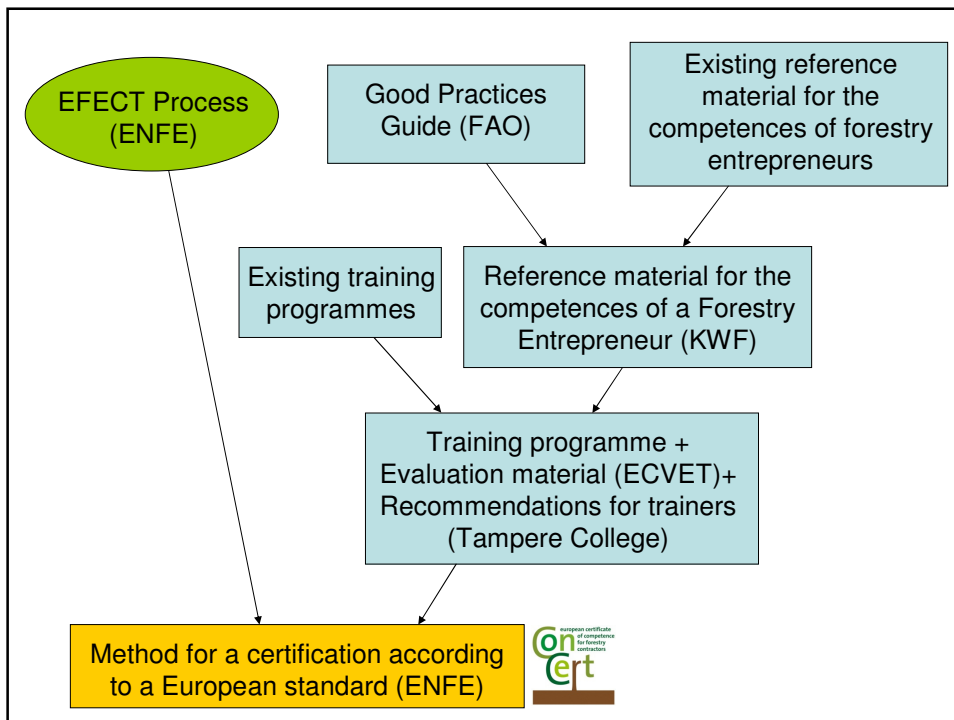

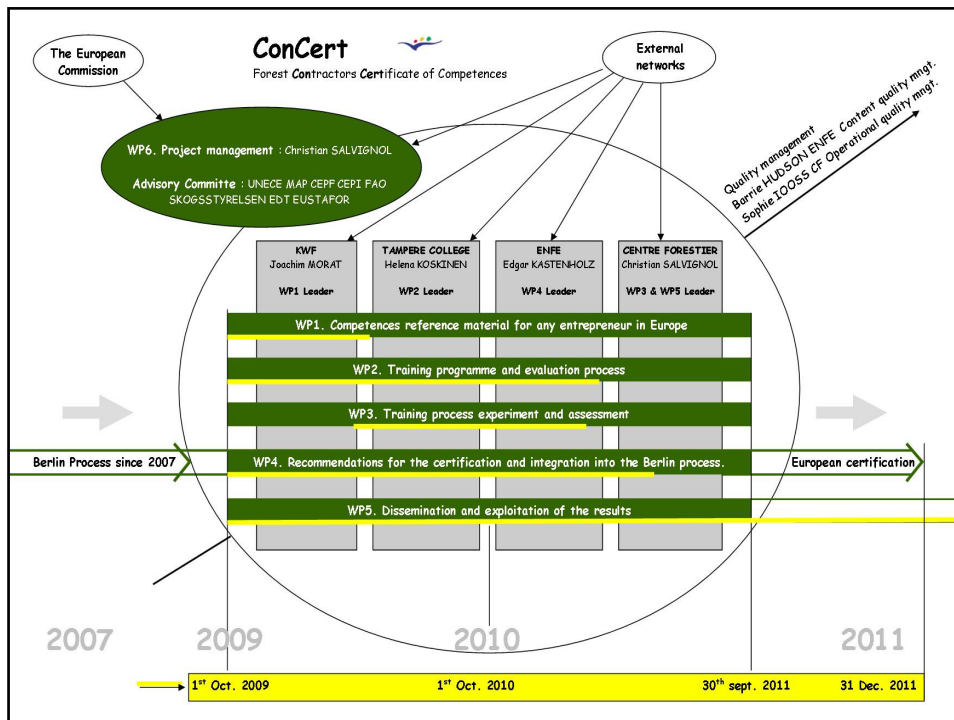

ConCert key dates

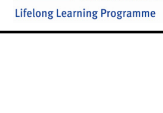
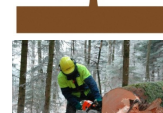
2009, October 1st : ConCert is launched.
